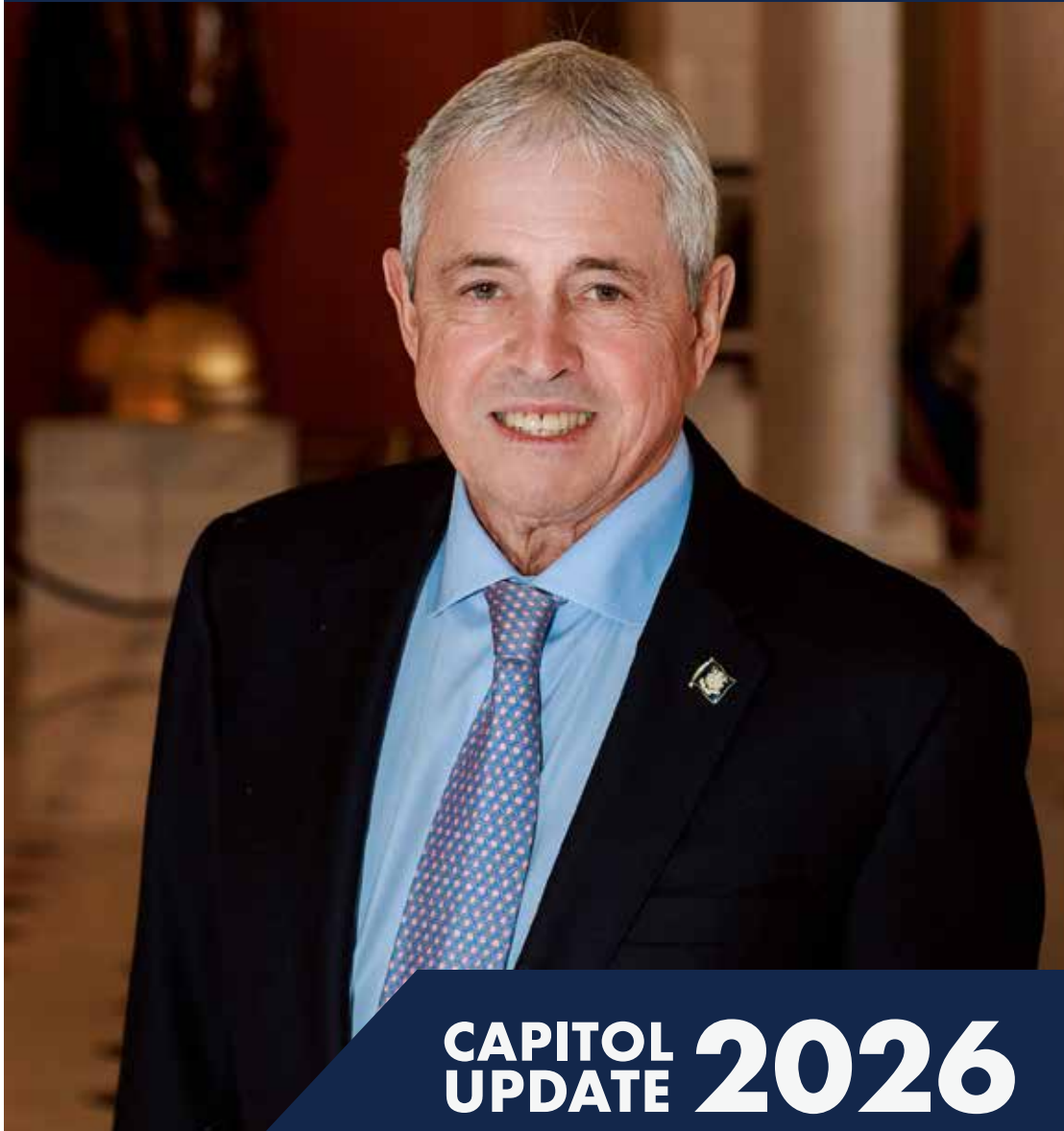

- \$190 million invested in public education for the 2026-2027 school year
- \$1.1 billion in pension liability prepaid down in 2026
- \$300 million for the Early Childhood Endowment Fund
