REP. BARAM EARNS PERFECT SCORE FROM STATE ENVIRONMENT GROUP

State Representative David Baram (D-Bloomfield, Windsor) has earned a perfect score from the state's leading environmental watchdog group, the Connecticut League of Conservation Voters.

The organization said Rep. Baram had a 100 percent voting record in support of key pieces of environmental legislation this session. He has also earned a lifetime score of 90 percent.

"I am honored to receive this recognition. Ensuring that our future generations enjoy a better Connecticut is one of my top priorities," Baram said. "Protecting our environment is a responsibility that we all share and must take seriously."

"Having clean air, land and water makes Connecticut a more desirable place to live and do business and I look forward to tackling more environmental issues next session," Baram said.
