## A BUDGET THAT WORKS FOR OUR FUTURE

Last year's bipartisan budget was balanced and didn't raise the sales, income, or capital gains tax. We now have \$3.5 billion in budget reserves – the maximum amount – in our rainy-day fund. We've prepaid more than \$1.6 billion of our long-term pension liabilities. Between reserves, paying down debt, and good economic forecasting, we've seen multiple creditrating upgrades for the first time in over 20 years. In addition to being a vote of confidence in our fiscal situation, this will save Connecticut money on infrastructure projects.

- Stabilized state and teacher pension systems
- Adopted sounder accounting methods
- Paid down \$4.5 billion in operational and pension costs
- Cut unemployment insurance taxes on local businesses
