You can delay paying bills if you have been impacted financially:

Mortgage payment forbearance is being offered by participating financial institutions for up to 90 days, allowing homeowners to reduce or delay mortgage payments. Contact your bank for more information.

Evictions and Utility shut offs are being halted until the crisis is over. If you do not pay these bills you will still owe it at the end of the crisis, but you won't lose these essential services during the crisis.

Insurance Premium Grace Period. CT is requiring that insurance companies grant anyone affected by COVID-19 be granted a 60 day grace period until at least June 1st. This grace period is not automatic, so contact your insurer.
