Reducing Property Taxes

- More state **money for Waterbury**
- Work to **increase property tax refunds** on state income tax returns
- Reduce city costs by adding municipal employees to the state health care plan

Training for New Teachers

- Develop quality mentoring programs between experienced and new teachers



Improving Nursing Homes

- Work to improve the **quality of care** and safety of patients in our nursing homes
- Increase minimum staffing levels so that direct nursing care per patient reaches national recommended levels
