IMPORTANT NEW ELECTION LAWS IN 2023

- **EARLY VOTING**

Connecticut will now join 46 other states in expanding the hours for voters to cast their ballot and vote in person!

- **ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

On 2024 voting ballots, Connecticut voters will decide if we will move forward with no-excuse absentee voting.

- **ADOPTED ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LAWS**

We passed legislation to further protect the voting rights of historically disenfranchised voters from discrimination at the ballot box.

EARLY VOTING HAS ARRIVED IN CT

Starting with the Presidential Primary in 2024

14 DAYS

FOR GENERAL ELECTIONS

Early voting starts on October 21 and ends on November 3 before the November 5, 2024 general election

7 DAYS

FOR PRIMARY ELECTIONS

Early voting starts on August 5 and ends on August 11 before the August 13, 2024 primary election

4 DAYS

FOR SPECIAL ELECTIONS AND PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARIES

Early voting will take place on March 26, 27, 28 and 30 before the April 2, 2024 Presidential Primary
