

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Connecticut started its vaccine rollout with our first doses going to health care workers and at-risk populations like residents of nursing homes under Phase 1A. More recently the vaccine registration has opened up to those 65 and older under Phase 1B. Vaccine eligibility will expand to the 55-64 age group beginning on March 1 and dedicated clinics for educators and childcare providers will be implemented in March.

The age-based schedule of eligibility will continue over the next couple of months for when people will be eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine.

- March 1, 2021: Eligibility expands to age group 55 to 64
- March 22, 2021: Eligibility expands to age group 45 to 54
- April 12, 2021: Eligibility expands to age group 35 to 44
- May 3, 2021: Eligibility expands to age group 16 to 34

To further ensure equitable allocation, DPH will set targets and work to administer the vaccine to the highest-risk populations.

What is the age-based approach to vaccine eligibility?

AGE-BASED APPROACH TO EXPANSION

96%

Age is one of the strongest factors contributing to COVID-19 deaths, with 96% of COVID-19 deaths in Connecticut occurring in people over the age of 55.

What does the age-based schedule for vaccine eligibility look like?

March 01, 2021 Expands to age group 55 to 64

March 22, 2021 Expands to age group 45 to 54

April 12, 2021 Expands to age group 35 to 44

May 03, 2021 Expands to age group 16 to 34

The Department of Public Health will set numerical targets and work with vaccine providers to ensure that vaccines are administered to people living in the highest-risk communities in proportion to their population.



DEDICATED VACCINE CLINICS

The State will have dedicated vaccine clinics specifically to vaccinate those in this sector.



PreK through Grade 12 school staff and teachers, and professional childcare providers will be eligible to receive the vaccine in March.
