HOW TO TRACK THE 2025 SESSION

2025 Session Schedule

Opening Day – **Wednesday, January 8th**

January, February, March - Committees hold meetings to raise and draft proposed bills and hold public hearings

February – Governor introduces 2-year proposed budget

February, March, April - Appropriations and Finance Committees begin holding public hearings and make budget adjustments

March, April, May - Committees have their Joint Favorable (JF) Deadlines to take final action on bills

April, May, first week of June – House and Senate meet more regularly to vote on committee bills (require both House and Senate approval to become a Public Act to be signed into law by the governor)
