## LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The legislative committees on which I serve are studying several initiatives, suggested by my constituents, aimed at improving our quality of life.

The Public Health Committee is considering bills to improve barrier-free access for individuals with physical disabilities, as well as access to information and services for those with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

The Energy and Technology Committee is considering bills to expand access to shared clean energy in our state, as well as requiring the Connecticut Siting Council to hold public hearings in the municipality where a proposed communication tower is to be located.

The Environment Committee is considering bills to encourage the recycling of household consumer batteries, as well as protecting state land, with conservation value, from being sold or conveyed to other entities.
