EARLY VOTING

This past session we approved a resolution that lets voters decide if Connecticut will join 43 other states in allowing early voting. The question will appear on the 2022 ballot.

NO EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING

We're also putting the question to voters in 2024 whether any registered voter should be allowed to vote by absentee ballot without needing an excuse.
