As House Vice Chair of the Public Safety Committee, I am proud to continue our work in making Connecticut a safer place for our families. While this session we are working on a number of bills to strengthen our public safety, I'd like to highlight last sessions work:

- Protected consumer health data by restricting its access and sale and banned targeted ads near mental health facilities (PA 23-56)
- Expanded GPS monitoring of domestic violence offenders (PA 23-106)
- Made it illegal for adults to solicit photos and videos from kids online, even if they're not explicitly sexual (PA 23-123)
- Required bright orange labels on prescription opiates (PA 23-100)
- Required trained EMTs to carry and use EpiPens (PA 23-97)

- Modernized our blight laws and extended local enforcement to commercial properties (PA 23-33)
- Expanded speed enforcement on rural roads (HB 6941)
- Improved data collection on crimes involving firearms (PA 23-69)
- Created electronic notifications for expiring gun permits to ensure gun owners don't let their permits lapse (PA 23-73)
- Formed a special police task force to deal with abuse of kids online (HB 6941)
