#### Strengthened senior programs that:

- Increased elderly nutrition and Meals on Wheels funds by \$2.5 million.
- Established a new free prescription drug discount card for all Connecticut residents to save on medications.
- Expanded Medicaid coverage for services such as primary healthcare, physical therapy, and more.
- Eliminated some taxes on retirement income such as pensions, annuities, and Social Security.
- Expanded eligibility for seniors to participate in adult day services, serving those with early onset dementia and established a new Dementia Services Coordinator position.
- Expanded Latino outreach for behavioral services in greater New Haven will include Latino behavioral health outreach for seniors.
- Created a new pilot microtransit service for the Hill, West River, Dwight, Edgewood, Beaver Hills, and West Rock neighborhoods, to be built out in coming months. Microtransit is an accessible, on-demand mode of transportation using a smartphone app or phone number to request and schedule a ride within designated areas. Stay tuned for updates!
