

Healthcare Services for Veterans

The Veteran’s Administration (VA) Connecticut Healthcare System is an excellent resource available to our veterans and their families. It includes an inpatient facility and Ambulatory Care Center in West Haven; an Ambulatory Care Center in Newington; and six primary care Community Based Outpatient Clinics throughout the state, including one facility in New London and one in Willimantic. They provide a variety of services specifically designed to help and support our veterans, including psychosocial, medical and educational long-term rehabilitation, as well as job training.
