- Established a registration system and annual fee for temporary nursing service agencies through the CT Department of Public Health to prevent staff shortages and price gouging in nursing homes.
- Streamlined electronic reporting of involuntary discharges or transfers in nursing homes and residential care homes to the Long-Term Care Ombudsman.
- Promoted non-traditional long-term care options by allowing the CT Department of Social Services to approve requests to build small-house style nursing homes rather than large facilities.
