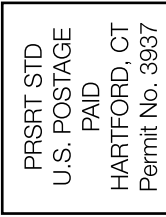

Dear Neighbors,

Connecticut started its vaccine rollout with our first doses going to health care workers and at-risk populations like residents of nursing homes under Phase 1A. Shortly after, the vaccine rollout was available to residents 65 and older under Phase 1B. In addition, vaccine eligibility had been extended to the 55-64 age group which began on March 1 and dedicated clinics for educators and childcare providers as well.

Most recently, Governor Lamont announced all Connecticut residents 16 and older will be eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine on April 5th. To further ensure equitable allocation, DPH will also set targets and work to administer the vaccine to the highest-risk populations.
