LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The legislative proposals that I am supporting this session are based on my conversations with many of you. Here are a few highlights:

Improving Services for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities - I cosponsored a bill that will enhance the quality of service and care for individuals with intellectual disabilities and the families/guardians that take care of them. The bill improves the management of waiting lists and keeps the individuals, and their families, informed of funding and services available.

Increase in Educational Funding - I am proud to support the continued increase in funds for education, in the way of general and construction grants, because I firmly believe in investing in our children's future.

Funding for Transportation - It is essential to keep Connecticut moving by supporting legislation that assists in repairing our bridges, highways, rail and bus services, as well as improving our bike and pedestrian infrastructure.
