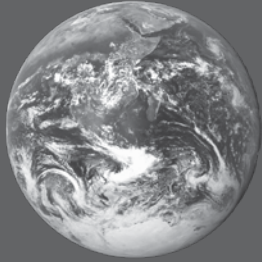

I've been committed to laws to do that



IN 2023, WE:

- Empowered the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to regulate factories and waste plants which pollute near residential neighborhoods. (PA 23-202)
- Held tire manufacturers responsible for recycling tires (PA 23-62)
- Banned the hand harvesting of horseshoe crabs (PA 23-6)
- Protected migratory birds by turning off lights in state buildings (PA 23-143)
- Funded municipalities to clean up PFAS – a forever chemical pollutant (PA 23-74)
- Funded capital spending for bicycle ways, greenways, and trails like the Marjorie Lake trail (PA 23-205)

IN 2024, WE'LL:

- Declare a climate crisis;
- Update the state's Global Warming Solutions Act to make our greenhouse gas emissions targets more in line with other states in the region;
- Create incentives for businesses and municipalities that engage in clean economy sectors or engage in environmentally sustainable projects;
- Plan for transition to clean economy, workforce training and long-term policy implementation; and
- Support and expand Nature-Based Solutions, such as preserving marshlands and forests
