The Community Health Center (CHC) of Danbury began in 2008 with a mission to provide help, care and access to growing communities. CHC offers primary medical care for children and adults along with programs like Behavioral Health and Breast Cancer Detection. Greater Danbury Community Health Center (FQHC)

The Greater Danbury Community Health Center covers everything from family planning services to geriatric medical care. The CT Institute for Communities non-profit organization instituted the Discounted Fee Program for uninsured patients which ensures access for all residents.
