PROTECTING OUR ENVIRONMENT

THIS YEAR I PLAN ON SUPPORTING LEGISLATION THAT WILL:

- Add a referendum question to this November's ballot asking voters to amend our state constitution to protect our public lands. The amendment proposes that public lands cannot be sold, traded or given away without adequate public input. Our neighboring states have already passed resolutions to this affect.
- Horseshoe Crab blood is vital to manufacturing vaccines that help protect us from disease. Spawning sites on Short Beach need protection so researchers at Sacred Heart University can continue their work studying these crabs. I introduced legislation last session to ban the harvesting or killing of Horseshoe Crabs in our area that passed overwhelmingly out of the House, but was never taken up for a vote in the Senate.
