



## MANSFIELD RECEIVES EXTRA FUNDING FOR LOCAL SCHOOLS AND SERVICES

I am pleased to share that Mansfield will get an extra \$2.3 million in education funding this year to help support our great schools and hold down property taxes. This increased funding comes as a result of \$150 million the legislature added for education aid to municipalities, combined with some pandemic-related population shifts. Additionally, Mansfield's PILOT (Payment In Lieu Of Taxes) payment will increase by an additional \$730,000. Combined, that's over \$3 million more bringing state aid to Mansfield to \$28 million.
