

Home Energy Solutions

This innovative solution for reducing your home's energy bills through a variety of energy efficiency measures is performed by your utility's authorized contractor. Call (877) 947-3873 or visit www.ctenergyinfo.com for more information on this and other energy programs.

Residential Energy Efficiency Financing Program

The Connecticut Housing Investment Fund is a program designed to help Connecticut residents make their homes more energy efficient by suggesting insulation and windows improvements, helping customers upgrade to ENERGY STAR heating and cooling systems, and improving the efficiency of existing hot water systems. CHIF can help you finance these improvements with low-interest loans made possible through sponsorship by the Connecticut Energy Efficiency Fund in partnership with various energy companies. Loans range from \$2,500 to \$20,000 with 100% to be used for conducting qualified improvements or equipment replacements. Call (877) 947-3873 or visit www.CHIF.org for more information.

Residential Solar Investment Program

The Clean Energy Finance and Investment Authority (CEFIA) administers the new solar photovoltaics (PV) residential investment program. The ultimate goal of the program is to support 30 megawatts of residential PV.

This program is limited to owner-occupied homes. Customers of both Connecticut Light & Power and United Illuminating are eligible. For consumers who purchase a solar PV system for their residence directly, the first 5 kilowatts (kW) receives a maximum \$1.75/W and the next 5 kW receives \$0.55/W rebate, which may be adjusted based on expected performance.

For consumers who do not purchase a solar PV system directly but enter into a contract with a company that owns/operates the system, there is a performance based incentive (PBI) available to that third party owner. There is also a bonus for using components manufactured in Connecticut.

Interested customers are required to have a home energy audit first, then select a contractor from a CEFIA approved list. For more information call (860) 563-0015 or visit www.ctcleanenergy.com.
