2019 PROPOSED BILLS CONCERNING VETERANS

HB 7244 An Act Concerning The Property Tax Exemption For Service Members And Veterans

Working with local veterans, I helped craft this legislation which would increase the property tax exemption and make it more beneficial by having a disability rating that increases the base property tax exemption. Certain disabled service members and veterans would get an additional \$500 property tax deduction and an additional income-based exemption of \$250 or \$1,000 depending on income.

SB 802 An Act Providing For Discounted Fishing Licenses For Certain Veterans

This bill would reduce by 50% the fees charged to a Connecticut veteran who has a U.S. Veterans Affairs service-connected disability rating of 10% or more for any sport fishing license, permit, tag, or stamp.

HB 7247 An Act Concerning Access To Veterans' Resources Information

This bill would require Veterans Affairs to collaborate with the United Way of Connecticut to ensure that the 2-1-1 Infoline program provides veterans who access the program with information on public and private resources available and the steps by which they can access resources.

Senate Joint Resolution 3 Memorializing Congress To Recognize Women In Cadet Nurses

I co-introduced this resolution that would ask that Congress recognize women who served as Cadet Nurses during World War II to be able to extend to them veterans benefits.
