THE SHORELINE RESILIENCY FUND

The Connecticut Shoreline Resiliency Fund is a low-interest loan program for state residents who are at risk of coastal flooding and would like to elevate their homes and flood-proof their businesses as delineated by the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).

Eligible properties must be located in either Zone VE or Coastal Zone AE as defined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and NFIP and be subject to coastal flooding.

SANDY RELIEF CENTERS

The Department of Housing operates Owner Occupied Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Intake Centers Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Homeowners are encouraged to call the program's toll free hotline at 1-866-272-1976 Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. to schedule an appointment or for more information.
