REP. JANOWSKI HONORS CT AUTHORS AT MARK TWAIN HOUSE

State Representative Claire Janowski (D-Vernon and Rockville) presented a proclamation at the Connecticut Authors' celebration held at the Mark Twain House in Hartford on September 1st.

Publishers, authors and industry professionals gathered to celebrate Connecticut authors and promote literacy efforts at the ceremony. The event was sponsored by the Connecticut Chapter of the Association of Special Sales. APSS-Connecticut is a non-profit alliance that encourages literacy initiatives in the community.

Rep. Claire Janowski, who has been a vocal advocate for education and literacy, presented an Executive Office Proclamation recognizing the talent of many local authors and literary figures such as Mark Twain and Harriett Beecher Stowe.

Janowski said, "It was an honor to present a proclamation on behalf of Governor Malloy to such a worthy group at this Connecticut authors' celebration."

The Connecticut authors event is sponsored by the Connecticut Chapter of the Association of Special Sales (APSS-Connecticut). The group is a non-profit alliance of authors, publishers and related industry professionals who encourage literacy in the community.

Rep. Janowski said, "It's a great opportunity to not only celebrate authors but also bring attention to the problem of illiteracy which is still prevalent here in Connecticut, and anything we can do to help solve the problem is a great plus."
