**If you have not responded, you can still be counted!** A federal census worker will visit the homes of people who did not return the forms and request the needed information in person. This mailer provides helpful hints about what to look for during the door-to-door visit.

## The 2010 Federal U.S. Census – THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING COUNTED!

### WHY A CENSUS?

The census count is required every ten years. Captured information is used to determine how much federal funding we will receive for projects and local services that benefit:

- Roads
- Transportation
- Hospitals
- Public Safety
- Schools
- Sewers
- Emergency Services
- Seniors
- Bridges
- Preservation
- Child-Care
- ...And Much More!

### HOW YOU CAN MAKE YOUR VOICE COUNT!

**If you have already returned your completed form, THANK YOU!** You are already counted.

**If you have not returned your form, you can still be counted!** Census Takers will visit homes of people who did not return the forms... so, to be sure your voice is counted, take a little time to give the worker the needed information! It's that simple.

### REMINDER: WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN A CENSUS WORKER

- An identification badge with an expiration date and a Department of Commerce watermark.
- A confidentiality notice about information given.
- Someone trained to do business outside your door.

### A CENSUS WORKER WILL:

- NOT ask for a Social Security number.
- NOT ask for bank or other financial information.
- NOT contact you through e-mail.
- NOT ask for money or donations.
- NOT try to enter your home.
