REP. KAVROS DEGRAW IS A VOICE FOR WOMEN

MAKING CHILDCARE MORE ACCESSIBLE AND AFFORDABLE

- Creates CT's Early Childhood Care and Education Fund to support childcare and early childhood education programs
- Launches a wage enhancement program for childcare providers
- Establishes the Tri-Share Child Care Matching PILOT Program

EXPANDING PAID FAMILY MEDICAL LEAVE AND PAID SICK LEAVE:

- Growing Connecticut's Paid Family Medical Leave program to capture all Connecticut residents
- Phases in Paid Sick Days for all Connecticut employees (Accrues 1 hour off for every 30 hours worked)

PROTECTING SEXUAL ASSAULT VICTIMS:

- Creates the Sexual Assault Criminal Justice Response, Enhancement, and Model Policy Advisory Council
- Establishes that it is a police officer's responsibility to provide immediate assistance to a victim at the scene of a sexual assault
- Expands the Office of Victim Services' Resources
