WOMEN'S CAUCUS LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

I'm very proud to serve on the CT's Women's Bipartisan Legislative Caucus which brings our Democratic and Republican women legislators together to work on bills that make a positive impact in the lives of women and families on a wide range of issues.

Here is just a sample of some of the bills:

HB 6569 - AAC The Minimum Age To Be Eligible To Marry

HB 5003 - AAC Education Funding In CT supplements education funding

SB 986 - AA Protecting Maternal Health expands maternal healthcare access and affordability

HB 5197 - AA Allowing Emergency Contraception To Be Sold And Dispensed Via Vending Machines At Institutions Of Higher Education

HB 6672 - AA Concerning Endometriosis establishes an endometriosis data and biorepository program.

HB 6273 - AAC Disclosure Of Salary Ranges On Public And Internal Job Postings to create equity in the workforce

SB 5 - AA Strengthening The Protections Against And Response To Domestic Violence expands the GPS monitoring of those with restraining orders and also provides funding for legal services for those in need

HB 5001 - AAC Resources And Support Services For Persons With Intellectual Disability will help with wait lists, jobs and transportation

HB 5194 - AA Establishing A Grief Counseling Program For Children builds on last year's children's mental health bill
