AFFORDABLE, QUALITY HEALTH CARE

This session, the legislature further reduced the cost of health care. These costs are an enormous hardship on individuals and families, and they are hindering business development and job growth in our state. In particular, I supported a health care bill that will allow non-profits and municipalities to join the state pool to purchase quality, affordable health insurance, saving them and the state millions of dollars.

THE COST OF ENERGY

Businesses and residents of Connecticut currently pay some of the highest energy rates in the country – a full 15 percent higher than any other New England state. We can't allow this to continue. That's why I supported legislation that will reduce energy costs, help overburdened residents and give businesses additional capital that can be used to create and expand jobs.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTIONS

Through the work of the Speaker's Task Force on Domestic Violence, I was proud to support legislation to further protect domestic violence victims. These bills overhaul the restraining order system and reform the bail bond process to improve the state's ability to regulate bail bond agents and prevent dangerous offenders from causing more harm.

VETERANS TUITION ASSISTANCE

This session I supported a bill that waives tuition fees at Charter Oak State College for wartime military veterans and members of the Connecticut National Guard. The brave men and women who keep us safe deserve the best educational opportunities that we can provide.
