I opposed the original housing bill from the 2025 regular session because the Fair Share model didn't fit our communities.

Now, after months of collaboration, we have a new approach that:

- Removes Fair Share
- Support towns with planning tools and funding for infrastructure and schools
- Lets municipalities set their own housing goals – no mandates, no penalties

This plan puts local control and common sense first – helping communities grow on their own terms and creating housing opportunities for families, seniors, and young people to call Connecticut home.
