EMERGENCY INFLATION RELIEF SECURED THROUGH APRIL 2023

WHAT WE DID:

- Extended gas tax cut through April 30th
- Extended free bus service through March 31st
- Funded over \$30 million in emergency fuel assistance
- Delivered premium pay benefits to over 150,000 frontline, essential, private-sector workers who worked during the pandemic
