One of the great privileges of serving as your state representative in Hartford has been working with and engaging with Byram residents through the Byram Neighborhood Association (BNA), local advocacy groups, and individual residents.

In spite of the legislative session being curtailed by the pandemic, I have continued to work on an exciting mural project and to resolve issues with the upcoming Frontage Road redesign. I expect both projects to move ahead soon. During my initial meeting with the BNA, Byram residents shared with me a number of issues affecting quality of life and safety in Byram including the lack of working lighting under I-95 at Ritch Avenue.
