IMPORTANT NEW ELECTION LAWS FOR 2024

As Vice Chairperson of the Government Administration and Elections Committee, I have championed voting rights to make sure our elections are safe, secure and accessible.

• EARLY VOTING

Connecticut will now join 46 other states in expanding the hours for voters to cast their ballot and vote in person!

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

In the November 2024 election, Connecticut voters will decide if we will move forward with no-excuse absentee voting in the state.

ADOPTED ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LAWS

We passed legislation to further protect the voting rights of historically disenfranchised voters from discrimination at the ballot box.

BEGINNING THIS YEAR EARLY VOTING ARRIVES IN CT

4 DAYS

FOR SPECIAL ELECTIONS AND PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARIES

Starting 5 days before an election and ending 2 days prior to the election

7 DAYS

FOR PRIMARY ELECTIONS

Starting 8 days before an election and ending 2 days prior to the election

14 DAYS

FOR GENERAL ELECTIONS

Starting 15 days before an election and ending 2 days prior to the election
