## COVID-19 Vaccine FAQ

Q: Can I get the vaccine if I am pregnant or nursing?

A: Yes

Q: Is the COVID-19 Vaccination safe for children?

A: Vaccinations are only offered to those 16 and older at this time

Q: Can people who have already had COVID-19 get the vaccine?

A: Yes. The CDC recommends getting vaccinated even if you have already had COVID-19 because reinfection is possible.

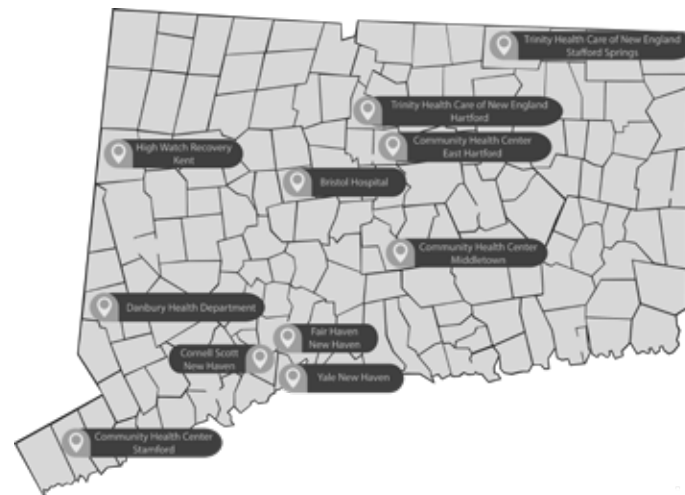
