## EARLY VOTING

This session we approved a resolution that lets voters decide if Connecticut will join 43 other states in allowing early voting. The question will appear on the 2022 ballot.

## NO EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING

We're also putting the question to voters in 2024 whether any registered voter should be allowed to vote by absentee ballot without needing an excuse.
