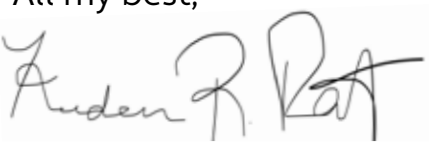




Above: Rep. Roberts was grateful to host the Norwalk NAACP Youth Council and students from BMHS in the House Chamber.
