INCREASING FUNDING FOR SCHOOLS

Last year, the legislature took significant steps in bolstering Connecticut's application for Race to the Top funding from Washington. This year we will revisit some of the measures that were put into place, while working with Governor Malloy to secure additional federal education funds.

HELPING SENIORS WITH GROCERY BILLS

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), the old Food Stamp program, has expanded its income requirements and benefit amounts, making it easier for more seniors to qualify for and afford their groceries. A household of two can earn up to \$2,248 monthly and still qualify for assistance. More information is available at: www.ct.gov/SNAP | 800-742-6906.

BULLYING

In November, the state's Commission on Children held a forum on bullying and cyber-bullying and their effects on school performance, self-esteem and mental health. This session, I am working on legislation to teach educators and parents about cyber-bullying, establishing clear policies to prevent, identify and address it.
