Together, we made a difference for Milford by drawing a line in the sand and fighting hard against cuts to our hospitals and funding for our bridges. We increased funding for our public schools and increased state dollars to the City of Milford. The details are as follows:

- **Protecting Milford Hospital** – We received a grant of **\$429,614** to maintain vital patient services.
- **Education Cost Sharing**– Milford received an additional **\$11,377,600** through the Education Cost Sharing grant to provide a better education for our students.
- **Grants for Municipal Projects**– We received an additional **\$1,344,868** from the state to help fund projects that will improve our city.
- **Sales Tax Revenue** – The city will receive **\$2,707,412** from sales tax revenue to aid Milford’s budget for the upcoming fiscal year.

## LONG ISLAND SOUND BLUE PLAN AND RESOURCE USE INVENTORY

Long Island Sound remains one of our most precious state resources. To protect the Sound, the “Blue Plan” will inventory the resources, uses and conservation areas of our portion of Long Island Sound. With this plan in place, the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection along with the newly established 16-member Long Island Sound Resource and Use Inventory and Blue Plan Advisory Committee will be able to more clearly and effectively manage our offshore waters through data-driven processes. It will also help streamline, allocate and coordinate our resources, including state agencies, academic institutions, and other stakeholders. Plans similar to this have been instituted by a number of our neighboring coastal states with great success.

## PROTECTING ELECTRIC CONSUMERS

The legislature stood up for consumers by giving electric ratepayers more say in the process of changing rates and protecting consumers from exploitative variable electric rates. Now, when UI or Eversource propose to increase rates, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) must hold at least two public hearings, which will allow consumers to speak directly with regulators. Connecticut residents are also now protected from electricity providers who offer very low introductory rates that rapidly increase. Connecticut is the first state in the nation to enact this important consumer protection law.
