WOMEN'S LEGISLATION 2017

PREGNANT WOMEN IN THE WORKPLACE *PA 17-118*

This act extends protections for pregnant women in the workplace by requiring employers to provide reasonable accommodations so women can continue working, among other protections.

PAY EQUITY *HB 5591*

This bill limits the defenses an employer may give to justify wage inequity. This bill was passed in the House, but not voted on in the Senate. New legislation with the same objective will be raised in the 2018 session.

FERTILITY *PA 17-55*

This law requires health insurance providers to extend coverage for fertility preservation treatments for those insured who may not be "presumably healthy."

EARNED FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE *SB 1*

This law would establish a Family and Medical Leave Compensation Program where beneficiaries could earn time to take off to care for an ill loved one. We will work hard to pass this legislation in 2018.
