

#### WILL THIS REALLY BE AFFORDABLE COVERAGE?

Access Health CT will make quality health insurance plans available at the lowest possible cost. Competition between insurance companies in this new market-place will help keep costs down. Also, many people will qualify for discounts, or may qualify for public health care programs at low or no cost.

### WHEN CAN I ENROLL IN COVERAGE THROUGH ACCESS HEALTH CT?

The first open enrollment period began October 1, 2013 and ends March 31, 2014.

Like other insurance programs, there will be an annual open enrollment period going forward. Existing users will be notified of the open enrollment period every year.

- Open enrollment will last until Mar 31, but will operate on a rolling basis.
- After March 31, 2014 you have to wait until October 15, 2014, to enroll, unless you have a qualifying life event (i.e. job loss, divorce).

#### WHERE DO I SIGN UP?

Go on the website (www.accesshealthct.com) to get more info or begin the enrollment process, call Access Health CT to compare the plans, or speak with someone knowledgeable of the plans to find out if you qualify for a tax credit.

If you want to speak to someone face to face (or if you have a more complicated situation, for example if you are buying insurance for your small business) the call center reps will refer you to one of hundreds of specially-trained brokers and community organizations.
