LEGISLATION

STATE REP. ELLIOTT IS FIGHTING FOR:

Adjusting Fiscal Guardrails

- Improves Connecticut's budget calculations for more accurate inflation adjustments.
- Refines spending limits and creates a consistent method for tracking revenue.
- · Includes economic impact analyses for state borrowing, strengthening fiscal stability and transparency.

Refundable Child Tax Credit

- Introduces a refundable child tax credit for tax filers below certain income thresholds.
- Provides financial support to families with children, easing the cost of raising children.
- Reduces income tax strain on working households.

Reproductive Rights Legislation

- · Protects the right to make personal reproductive health decisions.
- Ensures access to contraceptives, abortion, and related services without government interference.
- · Safeguards privacy rights and bodily autonomy, reaffirming personal choice.

Medical Aid in Dying

- Provides a regulated process for terminally ill patients to request medication to end their life.
- Requires physician confirmation of diagnosis, patient competency, and voluntary request.
- · Only the patient can initiate the request, with strict penalties for fraudulent activity.
- · Mirrors laws in eight other states, ensuring careful decision-making and oversight.

Food Waste Recycling & Donation

- Requires businesses (supermarkets, wholesalers, institutions) to recycle food scraps and donate surplus food.
- Diverts waste from landfills and ensures excess food reaches those in need.
- Promotes sustainability, reducing environmental impact, and benefiting the community and the planet.
