WHAT DOES "INCREASING SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION REIMBURSEMENT TO 50%"

MEAN TO YOU?

It means that if Cheshire residents approve the construction of new schools, Cheshire taxpayers will pay \$28 MILLION dollars LESS in their property taxes over the course of the loan.

RETURNING TAX DOLLARS TO CHESHIRE

- \$900,000 for Ball and Socket Arts to continue the economic development in Cheshire's West End Neighborhood
- \$150,000 for construction of municipal parking lot by the Linear trail
- \$200,000 for the Vietnam Memorial
- \$250,000 for Bartlem Park
- \$9.5 million for our schools
- Increased School Construction Reimbursement to 50%

OUR STATE BUDGET ALSO:

- Creates a Child Tax Credit \$250 per child
- Cuts taxes for retirees and increases property tax credit to \$300
- Extends the gas tax cut
- Makes historic \$3.5 billion payment toward past pension debt
- Creates a childcare rebate
