EMERGENCY INFLATION RELIEF SECURED THROUGH MARCH 2023

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

- Extended gas tax cut through April 30, 2023
- Extended free bus service through March 31, 2023
- Funded over \$30 million in emergency fuel assistance
- Delivered premium pay benefits to over 150,000 frontline, essential, private-sector workers who worked during the pandemic

LEGISLATION I INTRODUCED FOR LONG-TERM ASSISTANCE

- Create a business tax offset for local oil distributors who participate in a direct price reduction for customers.
- Grants for tertiary costs associated with installing solar
- Raising the income limits for energy assistance
