



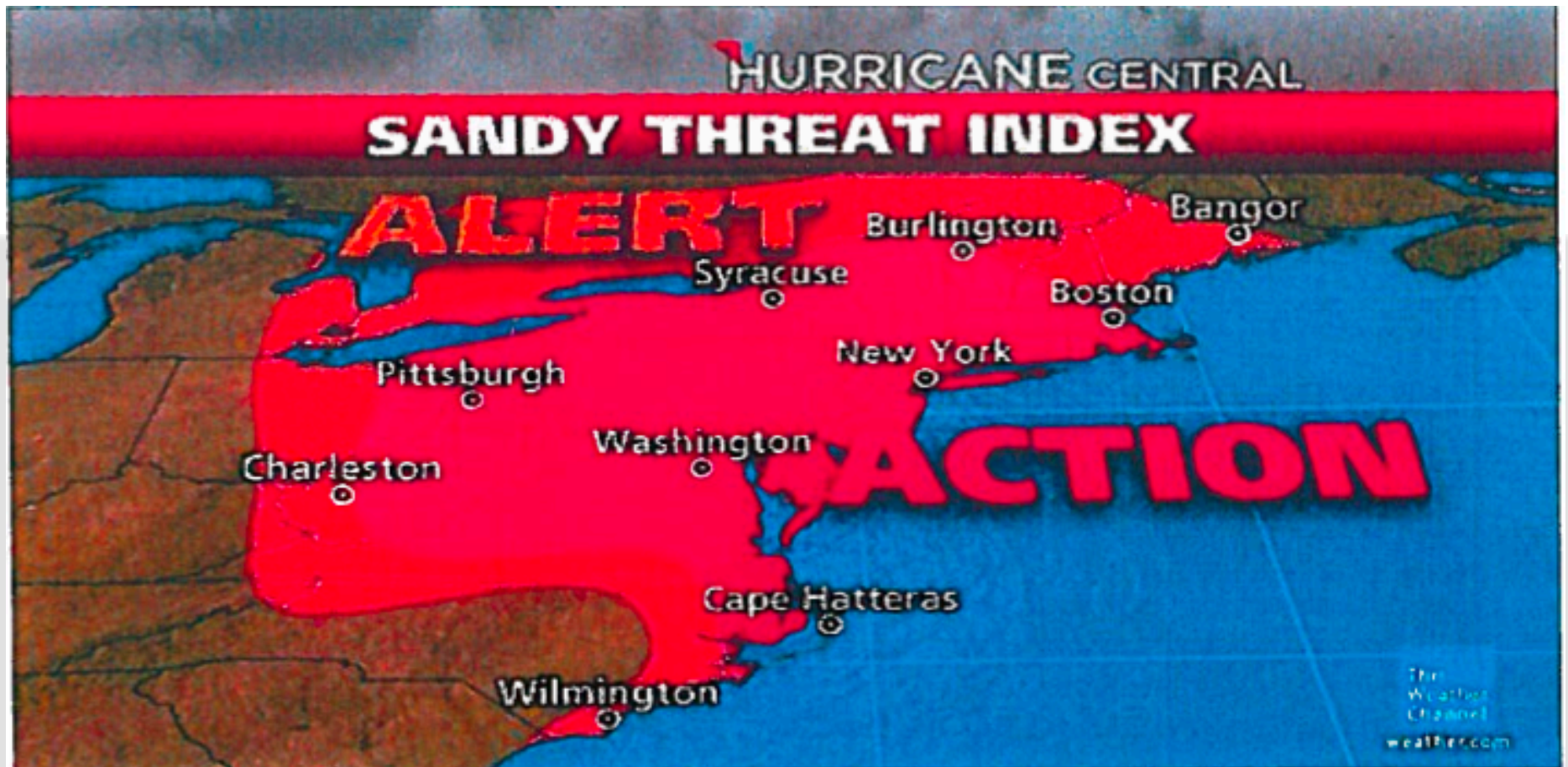

Hurricane Sandy

- Used by New Haven EOC 7x24 for eight days
- 1,000 unique incidents - peak incoming 80 per hour
- Veoci for communication, coordination and resource allocation
- City Administration in control

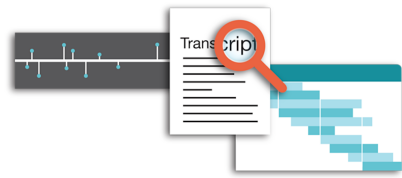
Veoci in Connecticut and beyond

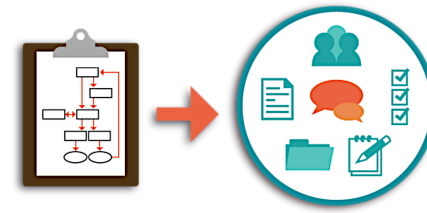
Next...

Virtual Emergency Operations Center on the Internet



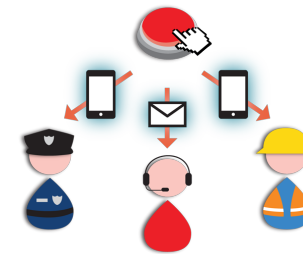
Analyze transcripts, view analytics and improvise plans.
