### **SUPPORTING OUR VETERANS**

Representative Rochelle proudly supported all of the following bills:

#### MILITARY AND VETERANS TRAIL

HB 5737 creates a state-wide military and veterans trail connecting monuments across Connecticut. This trail will help to easily recognize each landmark and the story it tells about the pivotal role veterans have played in our state. Connecticut would be the first state to create a veterans trail. This trail will attract history buffs, soldiers and tourists from Connecticut and across the nation hoping to learn more about Connecticut's veterans and military history.

#### **VETERANS' BENEFITS**

HB 5592 expands the definition of veteran to ensure LGBTQ+ veterans who were discharged solely due to their sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression receive the benefits they are entitled to. Our country's LGBTQ+ veterans have made great sacrifices defending and protecting our nation, and they deserve to be fairly compensated for their service to our country.



#### PURPLE STAR SCHOOL PROGRAM

HB 6483 removes a hurdle for military families in Connecticut by allowing military orders to be accepted as proof of residency for public school enrollment, and adopts "the Purple Star School Program," to ensure military-friendly schools.

#### HONORING DECEASED VETERANS

HB 6480 ensures that regardless of a veteran's financial status, they are honored with dignity by ensuring state funding, if needed, toward funeral costs.
