VOTING SHOULD BE EASIER. WE MADE IT HAPPEN.

EARLY VOTING

This session we approved a resolution that lets voters decide if CT will join 43 other states in allowing early voting. The question will appear on the 2022 ballot.

NO EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING

We're putting the question to voters in 2024 whether any registered voter should be allowed to vote by absentee ballot without needing an excuse.

MAKING SURE EVERY VOTE COUNTS

Connecticut residents will be guaranteed two hours off from work to vote in state and federal elections. We also paved the way for permanent drop boxes for absentee ballots making voting more accessible, all while protecting voters' personal information.
