HOW TO TRACK THE 2025 SESSION

2025 SESSION SCHEDULE

Opening Day – **Wednesday, January 8th**

January, February, March - Committees hold meetings to Raise and Draft Proposed Bills and hold Public Hearings

February – Governor Introduces 2-Year Proposed Budget

February, March, April - Appropriations and Finance Committee begin holding public hearings and make budget adjustments

March, April, May - Committees will have their Joint Favorable (JF) Deadlines to take final Action on Bills

May, April, first week of June – House and Senate meet more regularly to vote on Committee Bills (require both House and Senate Approval to become a Public Act to be signed into Law by the Governor)
