IMPORTANT NEW ELECTION LAWS FOR 2024

As Vice Chairperson of the Government Administration and Elections Committee, I have championed voting rights to make sure our elections are safe, secure and accessible.

- **EARLY VOTING**

Connecticut will now join 46 other states in expanding the hours for voters to cast their ballot and vote in person!

- **ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

In the November 2024 election, Connecticut voters will decide if we will move forward with no-excuse absentee voting in the state.

- **ADOPTED ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LAWS**

We passed legislation to further protect the voting rights of historically disenfranchised voters from discrimination at the ballot box.

BEGINNING THIS YEAR **EARLY VOTING ARRIVES IN CT**

4 DAYS

**FOR SPECIAL ELECTIONS
AND PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARIES**
Starting 5 days before an election and
ending 2 days prior to the election

7 DAYS

FOR PRIMARY ELECTIONS
Starting 8 days before an election and
ending 2 days prior to the election

14 DAYS

FOR GENERAL ELECTIONS
Starting 15 days before an election and
ending 2 days prior to the election
