CHILD CARE FOR WORKING FAMILIES

All of Connecticut's families deserve access to safe, quality child care. In Waterbury, over 1,000 kids participate in the Care 4 Kids program that provides financial support to low-income families so they can afford child care, enabling their parents to remain in the workforce. Unfortunately, in 2016, new federal guidelines forced the program to close to new applicants. Good news! With the state budget that passed, we were able to restore funding to the program, allowing it to reopen for enrollment and begin to address the 5,769 families who have been on the waiting list.
